## HERITAGE

The region of Dumbria has been inhabited since an early age. The remains of prehistorical villages appear along the region as dolmens, sepulchres, petroglyphs and Celtic Neolithic fortified settlements. You will discover an astonishing archaeological and artistic heritage.

### Archaeological history

The monumental dolmen of Pedra da Arca de Regoelle (3.500-2.700 B.C.) is a wonderful example of the megalithic architecture. It is one of the biggest in Galicia. From the same period and in the surroundings of Alto do Fragoso, we can see the cave paintings of Pedra Ancha. The ensemble of sepulchres in Olveira also stands out.

There are abundant ancient fortifications with Celtic origin along the region. The most significant are the Neolithic fortified settlements of Teixoeiras, Logoso, Regoelle, Alvarellos and Berdeogas, where a Romanesque altar has been found.

### Religious history

The church of San Pedro de Buxantes (18th Century) is one of the best beautiful construction in the region, which is attributed to Domingo de Andrade. In its inside is a choir made of stone.

The church of Santiago de Berdeogas has been built between the 16th Century and the 18th Century. It has a statue of the Santiago Apostle wearing as a pilgrim. In the surroundings of the temple are located the oak grove, the Neolithic fortified settlement, the centenary pigeon loft and a big stilt granary that form the typical card of the Galician rural. The influence of the baroque related to Santiago de Compostela can be visible in the altarpieces of Santa Eulalia de Dumbria or in San Mamede de Salgueiros.



The church of Santiago de Olveira dated back to 12th Century, but it has been remodelled in the 18th Century and in the 19th Century. The sacristy is attached to the apse. In its inside are the altarpieces with sculptures.

### Civil history

In the Santiago Way is situated the bridge of Ponte Olveira (17th and 18th Centuries), which was the scene of the Napoleonic battles. It has been built over an ancient Romanesque bridge, being the most representative construction of the civil architecture.

## ÉZARO VIEWPOINT

Visiting this viewpoint at the sunset is a unique spectacle, due to it is one of the most beautiful and astonishing viewpoints in Galicia. From this balcony we can observe an amazing panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean. On its left side we can see the Pindo Mountain, which is like a monumental wall that reflects all tints of the red colour. Over the horizon the sun is merged in the immensity of the ocean with the Fisterra Cape in the distance together with the sea inlet of Corcubión creating an astonishing landscape.

## SANTIAGO WAY

The Santiago Way to Muxía - Fisterra crosses Dumbria and is sprinkled by wonderful places to discover and modern facilities to enjoy. There are great attractions along this stretch of the way, such as villages made of stone, Neolithic fortified settlements, bridges, transepts, sanctuaries, legends and much history. In the village of Hospital is located the Pilgrim Centre with all useful information about the way and the public pilgrim hostels in Dumbria and Olveiroa with all services.



## A TERRITORY TO DISCOVER

In Dumbria you will find a fascinating and mysterious territory, where the water determinates the magic character of this region. In addition to this, the nature amasses landscapes with an incredible beauty.

In order to know this region you could do routes on foot or riding a bike along specific areas. For example, if you go to the Ferverza Reservoir, you will find an immense artificial lake which is integrated in the landscape. It is very recommendable in order to observe birds. Close to here is the Aula de Natureza, which is a place to rest where you could know better the flora and fauna.

It is very recommendable to go to the mountain path of Xallas, where you will discover the true brightness of this river. In this stretch, the Xallas River goes among the Pindo Mountain creating several granitic caves named as Plas or Caldeiras.

These formations with great ecological value sometimes retain water and acquire turquoise colour that contrast with the stone. Moreover, you will discover endless waterfalls that capture all colours of the rainbow.

This area is very recommendable to practise hiking "out of the route" or for people who are fond of extreme sports. Here they will find an ideal place to practice canyoning.



## A HIGH, CHARMING AND LEGENDARY WATERFALL

The Ézaro Waterfall is one of the most emblematic and beautiful places in the Costa da Morte. It is an icon of the nature that attracts every year thousands of visitors that were arriving here to contemplate this spectacle of water.

But this fascination is not new. Distinguished important people like Frei Martín Sarmiento, Manuel Murguía or Otero Pedrayo were leaving proof of this feeling in their books. The Waterfall is one of those incredible places with legends and history. Saracens and Vikings went to this area and there are people who think that the Vikings were repairing their vessels in a small shipyard situated in the estuary of O Ézaro.



## FESTIVITIES

In Dumbria there are festivities along the year but there are pointed dates when the different festivities takes place and they are a must.

The Carnival of Dumbria is one of the most famous carnivals in Costa da Morte, due to it is a success of participation, sense of humour and imagination. There are troupes, bands, orchestras, passacaglia music, and much colour and fun, which are guaranteed in this so special festivity.

The Beach Party takes place in O Ézaro with sports competitions on the national level like the Championship of Beach Volleyball, plays in the sand and the Beach Football. Moreover, there are the sardiñada (the sampling of roasted sardines) and open-air dances. It is a very recommendable combination. The Family Festivity takes place in the beautiful oak grove in Berdeogas. It is a festivity to enjoy the rustic aperitif, the sound of the bagpipes, the orchestras and the open-air activities.



## SPORT

Talking about Dumbria is talking about sport. It could say that this council is the sports heart of the Costa da Morte. It is not a coincidence that the Volta Ciclista a España (the Spain cycling race) has been crossed along the region of Dumbria three times.

Events like the Gran Fondo Ézaro congregates every year thousands of participants to live this challenge, climbing ramps with inclinations up to 29% to reach the goal in the Ézaro viewpoint. Moreover, the Galician Championship of Beach Volleyball, the Galician Championship of Canoeing and the World Fly-fishing Tournament attract every year thousands of amateurs. For the adventurous people there is nothing better than to test the Ferverza en kayak (routes by kayak to the waterfall), mountain bike routes, hiking, and paddle tennis in the court situated in the surroundings of the waterfall or canyoning in the ending stretch of the Xallas River, which is a very attractive option.

## CIR

In Ézaro is located the Interpretation Centre about the Pindo Mountain and the Ézaro Waterfall Routes. Here you will be able to widen the information about the routes and discover other new ones. You will also find information about its fauna, flora, history, legends, curiosities, interactive boards and videos.

## BEACH

Sheltered by the Pindo Mountain and close to the Ézaro waterfall is located the Ézaro beach with fine sand and quiet crystal clear water. It has Blue Flag and all services. This beach is ideal to disconnect with so refreshing and intense activities. Let's try the kayak in the Waterfall, the routes to the Pindo Mountain, a visit to the Interpretation Centre about Routes and the paddle tennis court.

## BRAZAL STONE

Close to the Santiago Way, in one side of the Castelo Mountain, is located this miracle of natural equilibrium. In less than a square metre is an enormous stone with 6,5 m that rides in perfect harmony on other big stone creating this spectacular natural sculpture with more than 100 tonnes.


